# HW Rulemakings in the works...

- Adopt federal changes and make clarifications and corrections
- Used electronics rulemaking – includes federal Cathode Ray Tube (CRT) rule
- Regulations for transfer stations – early outreach to start soon.

# Authorization Status

- Authorized by USEPA on August 31, 2009 for 3 rules:
  - Last large rule to adopt federal changes
  - Project XL for Public Utilities
  - Hazardous waste manifest regulations

# Next rule to adopt federal changes

- MACT changes from 1999 to present
- Other federal changes from 2002 to present
- State initiatives

# Federal Rules

- 29 proposed to be included....

## NOT included are:

- National Performance Track rules
- Standardized Permit rule
- Cathode Ray Tubes (CRT) rule
- Revisions to Definition of Solid Waste rule
- Expansion of Comparable Fuel Exclusion

# State Initiatives

- 50 items listed in Attachment 2 on the web
  - 5 more items identified since...
- Included issues from “old” State Initiatives rulemaking effort EXCEPT.....

# PCB Waste Regulation

- USEPA working to transfer PCB wastes from TSCA to RCRA.
- Once EPA is done, will review State regs for consistency with federal program and potential revisions will be considered at that time.
