Kenneth Adams is the Dean of Workforce and Economic Development at Bronx Community College/CUNY. Kenneth oversees Workforce Development and Continuing Education, the Office of Career Development, the Center for Sustainable Energy and Community and Economic Development.

Prior to joining CUNY, Kenneth was Acting Commissioner of the New York State Department of Taxation and Finance. From 2011 until 2015, he served as President and CEO of the Empire State Development Corporation (ESDC) and Commissioner of the NYS Department of Economic Development. Before joining state government, Kenneth led The Business Council of New York State, the Brooklyn Chamber of Commerce and the MetroTech Area Business Improvement District. He was the founding Executive Director of New York Cares.

Kenneth currently serves as Chairman of the Boards of Directors of New York State's affordable housing agencies, including the Housing Finance Agency, the Housing Trust Fund Corporation and SONYMA. He is also a director of the NYC Employment and Training Coalition and of the Queens Chamber of Commerce Foundation. Kenneth has served on the boards of numerous nonprofit organizations, government agencies and public authorities, and on multiple government commissions, councils and advisory groups on behalf of four governors and two mayors.
