Robert Malmsheimer, PhD, JD

Associate Chair, and Professor of Forest Policy and Law Department of Forest and Natural Resources Management SUNY ESF



Dr. Robert Malmsheimer is a Professor of Forest Policy and Law at the SUNY ESF, where his research focuses on forest carbon accounting and public policy. He chaired two Society of American Forester's Task Forces that evaluated how forests and their products can best address climate change, and co-authored an analysis and summary of 135 peer reviewed science articles on forests and bioenergy. He also co-authored the the "Forests" chapter of the 3rd U.S.

National Climate Assessment. Malmsheimer has provided more than 95 science-based policy briefing to national and international policymakers, including providing congressional testimony and giving two presentations at the United Kingdom's House of Commons. He is the recipient of the Sir William Schlich Memorial Award — the preeminent award in US forest policy — and the SUNY Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Teaching.
