I have been the Director of the Division of Air Resources for New York State since 2016. I've been employed by DEC for over 39 years in several different program areas, the last 25 years in the Division of Air Resources. The program has an annual budget of approximately \$38 million, and a staff level of 210 engineers, scientists, professional and administrative staff. The program is responsible for all aspects of State and Federal Clean Air Act related programs, including air quality monitoring, planning, permitting and enforcement, mobile source programs, research, and ancillary support programs. I am a member of the board of directors for the North East States for Coordinated Air Use Management (NESCAUM) and the National Association of Clean Air Agencies (NACAA), and currently serve on EPA's Clean Air Act Advisory Committee.

I have a Bachelor of Science and Master of Science degrees in Civil and Environmental Engineering from Clarkson University, and am a licensed Professional Engineer in New York State.
